From Father John . . .

Are the Sacraments in your life plans?

Of course, we know about Baptism and Eucharist. And there are obligations that guide us to receive Holy Communion regularly. But let me invite our attention to some other aspects of a faithful Catholic sacramental life.

The **Sacrament of Anointing** was once thought of only as the "Last Rites." But the Church urges us to avail ourselves of this Sacrament's Grace *anytime* in life that we are suffering bad or dangerous health. Prior to surgery also is a common time for Anointing. By this Sacrament our sufferings (though not necessarily grave) are united with those of Christ for the salvation of the world. You may also wish to make a Confession coincident with Anointing. Please do not hesitate to call on me at any time to meet you for Anointing. Contact me either through the Parish office (614-497-1324) or directly (740-503-2827).

While on the subject of Anointing, please remember the end of life situations for a family member. If health is weakening and death seems within days, it is time to gather for the Rite of Anointing with Viaticum (final Communion). There are prayers that accompany these Sacramental rites that make a powerful way to gather around the loved one while she/he is still aware and can participate. Most find this a loving way to say "goodbye' within the person's faith and the Sacraments. In contrast, I've been called to persons' deathbeds at the last moment and was sorry that the family was deprived of a more lively administration of the Sacraments.

The Sacraments are sure means of Grace that can lift us at various times in our lives.
