<u>MORE Looking Ahead</u>: I'm thinking about possibly expanding our St. Mary Parish Eucharistic opportunities. I'm **not** thinking of changing the basic Saturday and Sunday Parish Mass schedules. Instead, my concerns are for Mass and Adoration opportunities **during the week**.

Since arriving at St. Mary as parish priest, I've questioned whether we're meeting the various needs and desires of our people regarding Eucharistic worship. I would appreciate your thoughts. Our current schedule is: Daily Mass at 8:30, Tuesday thru Friday; Healing Mass with Anointing at noon on second Wednesdays; and morning Adoration with noon Benediction on First Fridays. I wonder: Would folks value the chance for a mid-week evening Mass? Should we have an early-morning Mass before people go to work? Should Eucharistic Adoration be expanded to offer periods after work? This is a sampling of the questions that occur to me. Please let me hear from you; I want to consider your ideas.
