#### Resurrection Past, Future and NOW!

Historical facts of the resurrection of Jesus from death and His bodily return following His crucifixion have been questioned and answered countless times. Evidence is convincing. Christ's Resurrection is foundational for our Faith; if it were not true Christianity would be a cruel shame! St. Paul said, "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins." (1 Cor 15:17).

The Creeds express the Christian's Faith, "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead." At every Mass of Christian Burial, we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ as the prelude to our own resurrection. St. Paul calls Jesus' bodily resurrection the "first fruit" in a future harvest of resurrection for all the faithful ... the glorious reunion of body and spirit. (1 Cor 15:20). A wonderful article by Joseph Scheumann highlights an important dimension of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ: "In Jesus believers are already spiritually resurrected. Those who believe in Christ already have been raised to life with him. "If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God (Col 3:1)." Christians are people who are being raised with Christ and can know the power of Resurrection, now. Resurrection is an "already but not-yet" reality because we are now in Christ! Through this valley of tears and struggle, we await in Hope the fullness of the resurrection to come. (Romans 8:22-13). May your Happy Easter be a time you realize anew the power of the Resurrection for your life, NOW!
