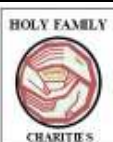

In the United States, the Blue Mass tradition began in September 1934, when Father Thomas Dade of the Archdioceses of Baltimore formed the Catholic Police and Fireman's Society. That year the first Blue Mass was celebrated. The name comes from the traditional uniform colors associated with law enforcement.
