
Welcome, Visitors! We extend a warm welcome to all the visitors who are celebrating Mass with us this weekend.



Pope Pius XI first instituted Mission Sunday for the whole Church with the first worldwide collection in 1927 in order to help emphasize our catholicity and universal solidarity in sharing in our common responsibility for evangelizing the world. 
