Christian Meditation

Thursday, March 15th at 7pm

"Be still and know that I am God". During this Lenten Season you are warmly invited to participate in the ancient tradition and practice of silent Christian meditation which brings us to that place of inner silence where "we are simply being with God who is in us in the Holy Spirit whom Jesus has given us" (John Main). We will be meeting in Church at 7pm on the Thursdays March 15th.

Christian meditation is a prayer of faith, "It is more important to experience its power in our lives than to try to understand or explain it", so let us deepen our spiritual life by joining together to meditate, making these two special evenings a beautiful part of our Lenten pilgrimage towards Easter.

The format for our meetings is very simple and will consist of gathering together, followed by a poem, a reading and a prayer. We will listen to a recording of John Main for about 10 minutes then a couple of minutes of gentle music, before meditating together for 20 minutes. We will conclude with some more gentle music and candlelight prayers. This invitation is extended with much love to all who have come to previous meditations and also to anyone who has never meditated before.

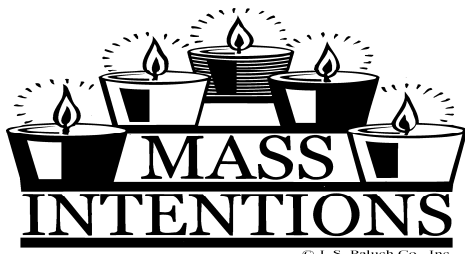

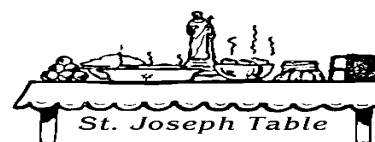


Over 50's

Social Justice

The readings today speak of God's love of humanity and His ongoing sense of mercy, manifested by Jesus' coming to us so that we might be shown the path to salvation. The message in the Gospel is significantly positive: He came not to condemn but "that this world might be saved through him." Webster defines mercy: "a refraining from harming or punishing offenders, enemies, persons in one's power, etc.; kindness in excess of what may be expected or demanded by fairness, forbearance and compassion." In the book "The Name of God is Mercy" (pg. 8), when Pope Francis was asked "What is mercy for you?", he responded "Etymologically, 'mercy' derives from misericords, which means opening one's heart to wretchedness. And immediately we go to the Lord: mercy is the divine attitude which embraces, it is God's giving himself to us, accepting us, and bowing to forgive. Jesus said he came not for those who were good but for the sinners. He did not come for the healthy, who do not need the doctor, but for the sick. For this reason, we can say that mercy is God's identity card." (Since we are all sinners, this affirms He came for us all.) As we well remember, Pope Francis felt so strongly for the need for mercy in our contemporary world that he gave us the Year of Mercy from 8 Dec. 15 to 20 Nov. 16.

The challenge for us people of Faith is to facilitate the linkage of the spiritual awareness of mercy to the secular

world. In doing so, we might be more inclined to live and expect our interactions with others to be governed by a sense of compassion under the umbrella of mercy.

The true test for each one of us is how we treat those over whom we have some sense of power/control; how we judge/enable our government leaders to function without a sense of compassion, without a seeming awareness of how the ultimate treatment of the undocumented, the incarcerated, the uninsured, the - -, (our brothers and sisters) impact the dignity, the humanity of us all.

Let us pray that the latest school massacre will not just be another footnote in history.

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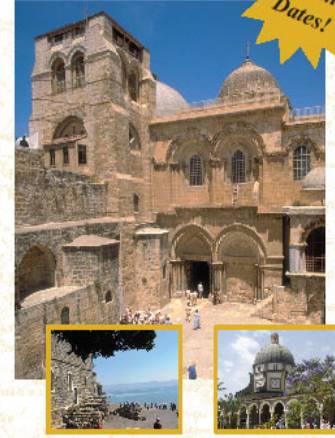

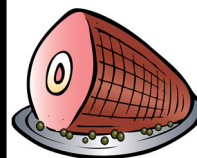


ENDOWMENT FUND
