

### ANNUAL MEMORIAL MASS



### “Who is this Jesus anyway and why do you want to follow him?”

Last Sunday the St. Christopher family welcomed those who are joining our community, those who have never been baptized or have been baptized in another Christian faith and those who desire to be confirmed. This is done through the Rite of Acceptance. All have been journeying together to more completely understand what it means to be a Catholic Christian and to be called a disciple of Christ.

The Rite of Acceptance is the first milestone on their journey to the Easter Sacraments. The rite validates their work and their participation over the past four months. It also confirms their desire to continue their study and devote their full energy in accepting the Catholic faith. Finally, it is an opportunity for you, the community, to welcome them and to show your support through your prayers.

Several weeks ago the class was given this training. A friend of yours hears you talking about your desire to become a Catholic. He hears you say that by becoming a Catholic you are committing to follow the teachings of Jesus Christ. Your friend does not know anything about Jesus Christ and asks you “Who is this Jesus anyway and why do you want to follow him?” As a group prepare a short paragraph that would answer this question and would incorporate the thinking of the group. Here are the responses from the three groups.

Jesus represents so many things: friend, confidant, teacher, savior, and hero. He represents the definition of unconditional love. He provides us the opportunity to redeem ourselves even at our lowest points. Being a Catholic is a lifelong journey to be the best version of ourselves in our relationship with the world around us.

Jesus is our Savior. Everything that is right and good. He is a leader and a role model who teaches not just through words, but by actions and commitment. He is love and shows us equality. He is both human and divine. He was the master of it all.

Jesus is Son of God who came to earth as Man to give up His life to save us. He fulfilled prophecies for our salvation. His gentle strength was motivated by His pure Love for all of mankind. His message was a message of forgiveness and non-judgement. A free gift to all those who want to accept it.

These responses are examples of our RCIA participant's growing faith and acceptance of Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Let us show our support through our prayers and our encouragement.





### BUDAPEST

Mass at the Basilica of St. Stephen. It is the co-cathedral of the Archdiocese of Esztergom-Budapest. St. Stephen (997-1038) was the founder and organizer of the Hungarian state and was Hungary's first Christian King.

### DANUBE CRUISE

A cruise of the Danube for a different view of this historic city. Our tour concludes at Matthias Church, a gorgeous Romanesque style church for a visit of the Ecclesiastical Art museum that houses numerous sacred relics and medieval stone carvings, including replicas of the Hungarian royal crown and coronation jewels.

### VIENNA

The capital and largest city of Austria. Apart from being regarded as the City of Music because of its musical legacy, Vienna is also said to be "The City of Dreams" because it was home to the world's first psycho-analyst Sigmund Freud.

### SALZBURG

Salzburg came to be in the year 696 when the missionary St. Rupert arrived in the area and founded the Benedictine Monastery of St. Peters. Today Salzburg is a picturesque city with small alleyways, quaint colorful town houses, rich castles and palaces, with styled gardens.

### OBERAMMERGAU

The story of Oberammergau is one of faith and began with a miracle. In the 1600s "The Black Plague" swept through Europe, striking down one in every three people and leaving in its wake misery, panic and death. The people of Oberammergau prayed to be spared, vowing they would present a play depicting the Life and Passion of Jesus Christ every 10 years. True to their word, the villagers presented their Passion Play in 1634 and have kept their pledge, the routine of plays only having been interrupted by the two World Wars.

Be a part of the once-a-decade Passion Play. As demand for tickets is high and space on tours will be limited, it's important to book your place as soon as possible. 
