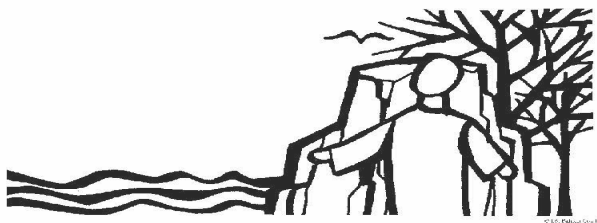

Social Justice

"A Litany for St. Martin de Porres:
Patron Saint of Social Justice"

On your mother's side Abyssinian slaves,
grandees from Spain on your father's. How
could someone dark as a Dominican kappa
with a burnt oak face and a halo of knotted hair
be the patron of holiness? Barbering and
sweeping were not causes for sainthood.

But there was no darkness in you. You were
simply not the right color for monastic vows,
something reserved for white faces, white
souls.

Later you begged Prior Lorenzana to sell you
as a slave to support the friars who questioned
why you prayed with your eyes closed. You did
not need to see what you believed in.

Seared in faith and charity you cared for
dropsically beggars, their heads full of fever
and lice, and made your bed for them to rest in,
folding their clothes in wreaths of rosemary and
myrtle. Everyone was welcomed in your small
cell. Even the rats there were safe. Miraculously
you walked through locked doors to care for
plague stricken seminarians removed from the
rest of the priory. When you died, a radiance
flooded Lima.

But segregation still haunted the Church. For
three hundred years you were a saint in-
waiting, invisible as the poor of Peru. Even your
statue was hidden in gloomy vestibules, out of
sight of white congregations.

It took a college of cardinals and a pope to end
the agony and declare your soul a mansion of
dazzling light in the same decade those black
souls marched across a bridge in Selma toward
martyrdom in Memphis.

BUDAPEST

Mass at the Basilica of St. Stephen. It is the co-cathedral of the Archdiocese of Esztergom-Budapest. St. Stephen (997-1038) was the founder and organizer of the Hungarian state and was Hungary's first Christian King.

DANUBE CRUISE

A cruise of the Danube for a different view of this historic city. Our tour concludes at Matthias Church, a gorgeous Romanesque style church for a visit of the Ecclesiastical Art museum that houses numerous sacred relics and medieval stone carvings, including replicas of the Hungarian royal crown and coronation jewels.

VIENNA

The capital and largest city of Austria. Apart from being regarded as the City of Music because of its musical legacy, Vienna is also said to be "The City of Dreams" because it was home to the world's first psycho-analyst Sigmund Freud.

SALZBURG

Salzburg came to be in the year 696 when the missionary St. Rupert arrived in the area and founded the Benedictine Monastery of St. Peters. Today Salzburg is a picturesque city with small alleyways, quaint colorful town houses, rich castles and palaces, with styled gardens.

OBERAMMERGAU

The story of Oberammergau is one of faith and began with a miracle. In the 1600s "The Black Plague" swept through Europe, striking down one in every three people and leaving in its wake misery, panic and death. The people of Oberammergau prayed to be spared, vowing they would present a play depicting the Life and Passion of Jesus Christ every 10 years. True to their word, the villagers presented their Passion Play in 1634 and have kept their pledge, the routine of plays only having been interrupted by the two World Wars.

Be a part of the once-a-decade Passion Play. As demand for tickets is high and space on tours will be limited, it's important to book your place as soon as possible. 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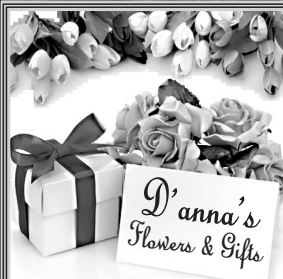
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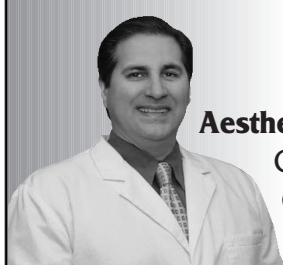
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
