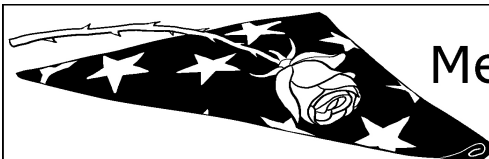
Registration for 2019 - 2020:
