Music in a Catholic funeral is not simply background—it is an integral part of the liturgy, lifting our hearts to God, comforting the grieving, and proclaiming our belief in the resurrection. Each song plays a specific role in the flow of the Mass, whether it's gathering us together in prayer at the beginning, giving voice to our trust in God during Communion, or commending the soul of the deceased to eternal peace.

Music choices are given above with recommended choices bolder. We encourage choices that reflect the Christian message of life, death, and resurrection. The Church provides many beautiful and familiar options, and our music and liturgy teams are here to help guide you in choosing music that is both comforting and appropriate for the sacredness of this celebration.
