

# RE-OPENING SOON

#### Our Parish's Re-opening:

The Coronavirus has challenged our lives in the last few months in ways that none of us would have imagined. All of the sacrifices that we have had to make, including suspending public masses, have been difficult. Yet we are doing our part to protect the common good and to ensure the safety of all our parishioners and staff. As we prepare for the opening of our parish for public Masses and other gatherings, I ask you to keep a few things in mind.

A general dispensation from the Sunday obligation will still remain in effect. In other words, you <u>are not required</u> to come to church until further notice. If you are in an at-risk health group or are just don't feel ready for public Masses, you should continue to stay home. If you are sick or have been recently exposed to the Coronavirus, please be considerate of others and do not come to the parish. Masks will be required of all who come. Yet, parishioners should understand that there is an assumed risk any time they enter a public space. If you do choose to attend Mass know that attendance at Mass will be limited. With only a small number of parishioners allowed at each Mass to ensure social distancing, your opportunities to attend may be infrequent at first. Please keep tuned in to our parish website in order to learn about these next steps that we will be taking. As of now, there is no set time frame for the reopening of our church for Masses. We believe, though, that it will begin soon. More information will be coming. We look forward to being again with you at Mass. Remember, your safety is a priority for us!

A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

#### **Pentecost Sunday** May 31, 2020

"Brothers and sisters: No one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God which produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit...For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body...and we were all given to drink of the one Spirit."

We proclaim that Jesus is Lord, and everything that goes along with it. He is Savior, Teacher, Brother. Because the Spirit dwells in me, I do not hesitate to make this assertion.

Take a moment, to reflect upon the gifts I see in others. They too are signs that the Spirit dwells in that person. Do not he sitate to mention your respect for them because of the presence of the Spirit and the gifts they possess. It might be the special moment to awaken in them the need to continue to exercise these God given gifts. Do I find charity, kindness, humility, the spirit of evangelization, holiness in them?
