FROM FR. PAUL

My dear friend in Christ, I hope you are doing well. Life at Our Lady of the Lake continues to move 'full steam ahead' as we plan for a spiritual and physical renewal of our parish.

As you may know, our school building is for sale. With the funds from the sale, we will begin plans to build a Parish Center that will be used to house parish staff and be a place for ministries to meet and a gathering space for our faith community.

Before this comes to fruition, there are two current and pressing needs to address and I ask for your help to make them happen.

First, we need a temporary space for our ministries to meet until our Parish Center becomes a reality. We are refurbishing the interior of the Small House by the Church so that it can be used as a meeting space for our parish. We are keeping a careful eye on the costs given its temporary nature, but it requires an update so that it can function as a 'stop-gap' measure and so our faith life can continue to flourish.

Second, our church roof which was decades old and covered in mold and clearly showed signs of deterioration has been repaired.

The total cost of these two projects will be \$55,000. This investment in our physical plant is an investment in our future. It will enhance our parish and be a sign to everyone in Mount Arlington that Our Lady of the Lake is a thriving and welcoming faith community.

In order to raise these much-needed funds, I am asking every parish family to consider a gift of \$500 paid over 5 months. I hope that 5 payments of \$100 is something most families will be able to do. I also know that some families may not be in a position to give this amount while others can do even more. Please know that every gift given with love for God and His Church will be a priceless blessing!

I ask you to do two things: 1) Please complete the enclosed pledge card and return it to Church in the response envelope. Put the word "Roof" in the memo of your check. 2) Pray for the success of this important and necessary drive so that our parish can continue to be a beautiful gem shining on the edge of Lake Hopatcong.

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

First Reading: 2 Samuel 5:1-3

Samuel describes how all the tribes of Israel went to David in Hebron and said they were his bone and his flesh and it was he who led them back to Israel. The Lord told David he would be a shepherd to His people. David made an agreement with the elders and was anointed king.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:12-20

Paul explains to the Colossians that God has made them fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light and that through the Son we have redemption and forgiveness of sin. He describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God, the head of the church and in Him all things hold together.

Gospel: Luke 23:35-43

Jesus is mocked by the crowd as he hung on the cross. Above him was an inscription that read “This is the king of the Jews.” One of the men being crucified with Jesus tells Him to save them and Himself, while the other asks that he be remembered when Jesus is in his kingdom. Jesus said in reply, “Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise.”
