The Catholic Mass has four distinct parts, each equally important to the other. It is recommended that in order to fully receive the benefits the Mass and all the Holy Eucharist has to offer we should try to be present, physically and mentally, through the entire Mass service.

Introductory Rights - Entrance, Gloria, Opening Prayer, etc.

Liturgy of the Word - First Reading, Responsorial Psalm, Second Reading, Gospel, Homily, Procession of Faith

Liturgy of the Eucharist - Preparation of Gifts, Eucharistic Prayer, The Lords Prayer, Breaking of Bread, Communion

The Concluding Rites - Announcements, Blessing, Dismissal, Procession.
