Did You Know?

Feast of the Immaculate Conception

On December 8th, we celebrate the feast of Mary's Immaculate Conception. To be clear, this solemnity is to honor Mary being conceived in the womb of St. Anne and not the conception of Jesus as many Catholics and non-Catholics misunderstand. Pope Piux IX declared the infallible doctrine that Mary was preserved free from all stain of original sin in the instant of her conception. This dogma makes sense because how could one with sin hold the Holy of Holies in her womb? For Mary to give her "yes" or "fiat" to become the mother of God, she needed to be sinless.

The Catholic Church encourages devotion to Mother Mary, the first saint, because she wants to lead us to her son. St. Maximilian Kolbe said, "Never be afraid of loving Mary too much. You can never love her more than Jesus did."
