

Plenary Indulgence for the Poor Souls

An indulgence is defined as "the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned." The first thing to note is that forgiveness of a sin is separate from punishment for the sin. We obtain forgiveness through the sacrament of confession, but we aren't let off the hook as far as punishment goes. Indulgences are two kinds: partial and plenary. A partial indulgence removes part of the temporal punishment. A plenary indulgence removes all of it. This punishment may come either in this life, in the form of various sufferings, or in the next life, in purgatory. What we don't get rid of here, we suffer there. Since a plenary indulgence removes all of the temporal punishment for sin, which is the reason why souls are in Purgatory in the first place, applying a plenary indulgence to one of the Holy Souls in Purgatory means that the Holy Soul is released from Purgatory and enters Heaven.

General rules for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

- 1. Be in a state of grace when performing the indulgence act.
- 2. Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin.
- 3. Confession (20 days before or after the indulgence act).
- 4. Communion (20 days before or after the indulgence act).
- 5. Prayers for the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after the indulgence act).

<u>Indulgence acts to be performed to obtain a plenary indulgence:</u>

- November 1-8: Visit a cemetery in these days to prayer for poor souls.
- All Souls Day: On this day, visit a Church. pray one Our Father and one Apostles' Creed for the Pope's intentions.

A partial indulgence can be obtained at any time by visiting a cemetery anytime.

The following prayer is especially recommended:

Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen
