Ways to Pray for Holy Souls

- 3. Give alms as a material penance for Holy Souls.
- 4. Sprinkle holy water on the ground for the spiritual benefit of the suffering souls.
- 5. Pray the Divine Mercy.
- 6. Visit a cemetery (pray especially for those who have no one to pray for them).
- 7. Stay in the state of grace with confession and the sacraments. This will make your prayers for the souls of others more effective.






Advent Meditations with the Holy Family
