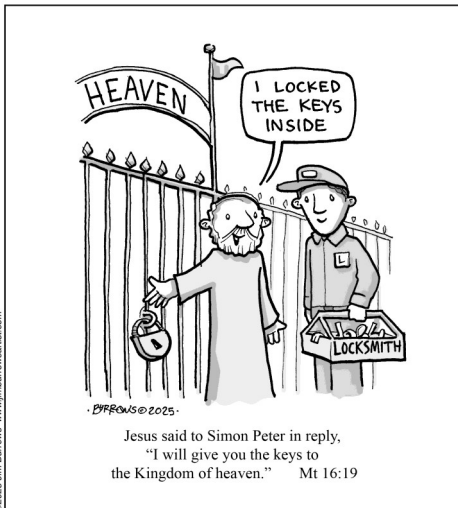
### Summer Break

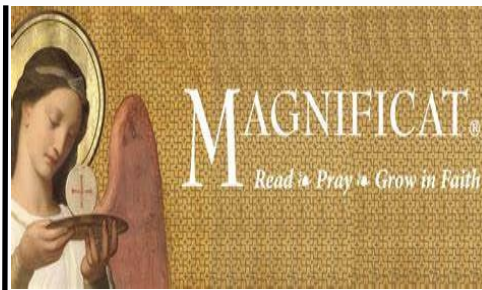
### A Prayer for Our Country

central theme of the movie is based on a poem, "Song of Myself," written by the Walt Whitman.

In a central scene of the movie, Chuck's grade school teacher explains a particular line in Whitman's poem, which the class was studying, suggesting to Chuck that we hold the universe in our heads (*I am large, I contain multitudes*). Chuck's teacher goes on to explain that everything we see, touch, feel or smell; all our interactions with life are stored at some level in our brains. Every detail of every day miraculously and mysteriously stored, as Chuck's teacher explains, "between your ears," as she lovingly cradles his head in her hands; a universe of experiences unique to each person that walks upon this earth.

After the movie, I got to thinking about my parents, who died many years ago, as well as my middle brother who died last year; they took with them an incalculable number of experiences and memories, much of which are now lost forever. Sadly, I have often wished that I had sat down with each of them and documented some kind of history of their lived experience. What was the address of the house they lived in when I was born (Oakland, CA). What was the address of the house they lived in Baker, OR when I was a toddler. How did my parents first meet and what were the first words spoken to each other when they met. What were their the darkest and the brightest days of their life and so much more.

In this week's Gospel reading, Jesus challenges the disciples with a question, "But who do you say I am?" Fortunately, the closing statement of John's Gospel assures the faithful that much of Jesus' life is documented but "There are many other things that Jesus did . . . I do not think the whole world would contain enough books that could be written." (John 21:24) We do know that the universe *did* reside in Jesus' brain since he affirmed his *eternal* existence, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last the Beginning and the End." So not all was lost. Amen?
