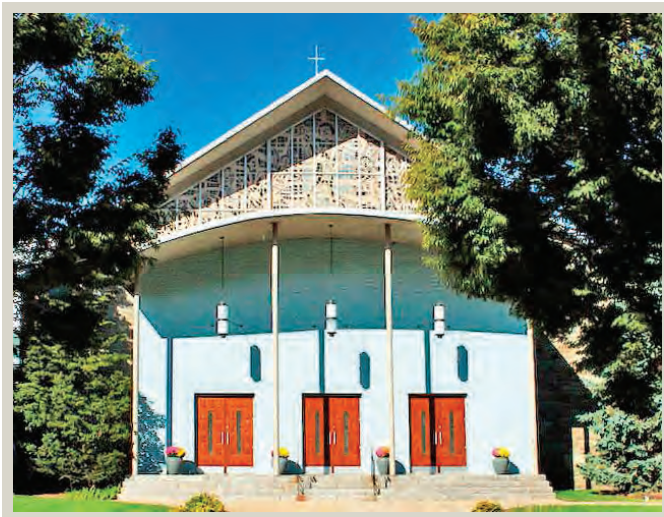

Did you know why we sit, stand, kneel at Mass?

We pray with our whole body. We don't just pray with our minds and words. So, by sitting, standing, and kneeling, we are actually praying with our whole bodies. What does standing mean? Standing is a sign of reverence and readiness. We stand at the beginning of Mass, at the Gospel and during the Eucharistic Prayer. We also sit at Mass. We sit for the readings as we listen to the Word of God. Sitting is a posture of receiving, that we may hear and process the Word. Finally, we kneel. We kneel at the consecration. We kneel in adoration and worship. So, when we come to Mass, let us try to remember why we sit, stand and kneel.
