Recent Examples of Savings

• Staples Advantage vs Amazon

In 2020 the regional schools asked ICS and Staples to compare 525 items the regional schools purchased from Amazon with the same items on the ICS Staples Advantage program. The total cost of the Amazon purchases was \$13,405, compared to \$11,468.68 from ICS Staples Advantage. **We would have saved the schools 14.4%**. In addition, there are no fees for shipping through the ICS Staples Advantage program and items are generally delivered the day after they are ordered.

• Staples Advantage vs. Quill.com

ICS was asked to compare actual school invoices from Quill.com with the same 26 items on the ICS Staples Advantage program. The total cost from Quill.com was \$1,022.73, compared to \$883. 63 from the ICS Staples Advantage program. **We would have saved the school 13.6%.** Actually, the Quill invoices were from an earlier period than the ICS Staples Advantage calculation and we did not calculate inflation that occurred in the interim. The actual saving for the school would have been higher.

Staples Technology Solutions vs. a non-ICS vendor

In September, a school was determined to buy 60 Chromebooks. Working on their own, school staff contacted various vendors and ultimately chose a third-party vendor for Konica Minolta (KM). Although KM is an established vendor with ICS, the school purchase was not coordinated with ICS. The school paid \$20,750 for the Chromebooks and accessories.

Later, ICS was asked for a comparison quote. ICS did its typical due diligence and requested a quote from another trusted vendor, the Staples Technology Solutions division, for the same items. If this purchase had been made through ICS, the cost would have been \$17,671.20. **We would have saved the school 14.8%.**
