SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: by appointment only for both Baptism preparation and Baptism date. Call the parish office at 410-879-4015 ext. 20. One sponsor must be a confirmed, practicing Catholic. Both must be Christians. Attendance at Baptism Preparation Class is required. Parents are encouraged to attend this Class before the birth of their baby.

FROM FR. KUNKEL

In this week's Gospel the Apostle Thomas is experiencing a crisis in faith. On the first Easter night, when Jesus had appeared to the disciples who had gone into hiding, Thomas was absent. When they told him that they had seen the risen Lord, Thomas doubted. "Unless I see the holes that the nails made, and unless I can put my hand into his side, I refuse to believe," said Thomas.

Then it happened! Eight days later, Jesus again appeared to the disciples and this time Thomas was present. Jesus spoke to Thomas: "Look, here are my hands. Give me your hand; put it into my side. Doubt no longer, but believe." To which Thomas replied, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus answered, "You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe!"

Only when we begin to live the new life in Christ, only when we begin to carry out our Christian ministry of loving service, do we really begin to understand what Jesus meant when he said, "Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe."

The philosopher, Frederic Nietzsche, an atheist, once was talking to a group of Christians who were trying to convert him. He is reported to have said to them, "Show me first that you are redeemed, and then I will listen to your talk about a Redeemer." We have no way of knowing whether or not he was actually sincere in what he said. However, assuming for a moment that he was truly sincere, if he had known you, if he had really known you, would he have been willing to listen to you talk about your Redeemer? Has your faith in the Risen Christ made that much difference in your life?

“FIELD OF THE INNOCENTS”

While you celebrate the re-birth of our Savior among your family and friends, remember in your prayers those whose opportunity for life was ended before they had a chance to enjoy it.



For the 15th year, St. Mary's Respect Life Ministry has set up the "Field of the Innocents" display of small white crosses representing the staggering abortion statistics in the United States.

Each of the 139 crosses displayed represents a pre-born child killed by abortion every hour of every day in this country.

Over 50 million pre-born infants have died "legally" since 1973 in this country alone. To put this figure into perspective, this means that there were more American victims of legal abortions in 2015 than there have been American casualties in the Revolutionary War, the Civil War, World Wars I and II, the Korean Conflict, the Vietnam War, the Gulf War, and the current war in the Middle East – combined.

Please reflect upon the crosses of the innocent young ones – for whom Christ died as much as He did for those of us fortunate enough to have been allowed to be born -- and resolve to pray with us for an end to abortion.
