

Theology of the Body.


There is no cost for the Theology of the Body class (although free-will donations will be accepted on the day of the class).

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

This chaplet is said on ordinary rosary beads.

Our Father..., Hail Mary..., The Apostles' Creed.

Then, on the OUR FATHER beads you will say the following:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ,in atonement for out sins and those of the whole world. (Diary of St. Faustina, 476)

On the HAIL MARY beads you will say the following words:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Concluding Doxology (three times):

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Optional Concluding Prayer (Diary, 950):

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

The History of the Chaplet

In 1935, St. Faustina received a vision of an angel sent by God to chastise a certain city. She began to pray for mercy, but her prayers were powerless. Suddenly she saw the Holy Trinity and felt the power of Jesus' grace within her. At the same time she found herself pleading with God for mercy with words she heard interiorly the first prayer of what would become the chaplet of Divine Mercy (Diary 476).

In subsequent revelations, the Lord made it clear that the Chaplet was not just for her, but for the whole world. He also attached extraordinary promises to its recitation.
