



## St. Joseph's Catechism Study



Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. They bear witness to this responsibility first by creating a home where tenderness, forgiveness, respect, fidelity, and disinterested service are the rule. The home is well suited for education in the virtues. CCC 2223.

The fecundity of conjugal love cannot be reduced solely to the procreation of children, but must extend to their moral education and their spiritual formation. "The role of parents in education is of such importance that it is almost impossible to provide an adequate substitute." The right and the duty of parents to educate their children are primordial and inalienable. CCC 2221.

Let's Come Together to Listen, Respond and Share with each other what we have come to understand through the study of the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

The word "catechesis," closely related to the word "catechism," comes from the Greek language, and it originally pertained to theatrical performances. It means "to make resound like an echo." Early Christians used the term to apply to someone who proclaims and teaches the faith—a person who echoes what he or she has learned from Jesus. At the same time, catechesis is intended to produce a corresponding echo in the hearts and minds of listeners, who respond to the truth of the Word that they hear. The Church considers catechesis to be an echo of the voice of Jesus himself.

Paragraph 2688 of the *Catechism of the*Catholic Church directly relates catechesis to
Bible study and prayer: "The catechesis of
children, young people, and adults aims at
teaching them to meditate on the Word of God
in personal prayer, practicing it in liturgical
prayer and internalizing it at all times in order
to bear fruit in a new life."


