A Letter from our Pastor

Dear Friends,

There's a catch phrase used by the American Red Cross regarding lifesaving in and around the water: Reach. Throw. Row. Go. These four words are the protocols to follow when rescuing someone in danger of drowning.

The first method is to reach out with a long hooked rescue pole. When that's not possible, then you should throw out a life ring. Your next recourse would be to row a rescue boat out to the victim. If none of these is possible, only then would you engage in the most drastic measure of all: go. This is the last resort because diving into the water subjects the rescuer to the same perils facing the victim. These might include riptides, dangerous depths, cross-currents and even sea predators.


This weekend we find Jeremiah trapped in a cistern. King Zedekiah dispatches men to pull him up because he fears the prophet will die. In the Letter to the Hebrews we are reminded that God didn't just reach out with an object or toss us a line. Rather, he entered fully into our sea of danger by becoming one of us. In today's Gospel, Jesus yearns for his baptism. Put another way, Jesus desires to enter into the waters that threaten to drown us, whereby not only saving us, but doing so in the most self-sacrificing and meaningful way.


Down the shore, on lakes or at swimming pools this time of year we find reassurance in signs reading: LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. All the more then should we find peace knowing that Jesus is always on duty with his saving protection. For without him, we'd be a shallow people treading deep waters where the only sign posted may as well read: SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!
