Capital Campaign Update:

Facilities Faith Lift II: Our Pledge Period ended on 6/30/21. To date, we have received \$767,597.13 in pledges from 259 parish families. Total pledges **paid to date** are: \$747,794.77 (97.4% of total pledge amount). The pledge **balance due** is \$19,802.36 (2.6% of total pledge amount). We will continue to collect payments on pledges for the remainder of the 2022 year.

\$44,943.78 was initially advanced from other existing accounts to pay off the final Burkey Construction bill once the renovation was complete. To date, we have paid back \$11,500 which was borrowed with pledge receipts since. The goal is that with an anticipated 60% satisfaction rate of remaining pledge payments, we will have a net shortfall of approximately \$20,000.

Building Expansion: No Update

Parish Giving – Online Collections Program: As of this report, we have a total of 174 parish families who have signed up for online Sunday Collections to date. The projected average **monthly** online Sunday Collections is currently \$21,653.42, and our **annual** online Sunday Collections total is predicted to be \$259,841, which is approximately 42.7% of our Sunday Collections budget for this fiscal year of \$609,165.

100th Anniversary Celebration:

Dinner/Dance tickets are \$40 per person. They are available online. In person sales will be March 19-20 and April 2-3.

New Business:

By-Law changes: There were no objections to the proposed By-Law changes, thus, approved.

Fundraising: Net income from the February Daily Lottery Fundraiser was \$3000. Attic Treasures is scheduled for April 22-24, 2022 in Quinn Hall. Items will be accepted during the week of April 18, 2022. No new events are scheduled at this time.

Knights of Columbus: Our last meeting was on March 15, 2022 with full Council. There will be officer nomination and elections in the next few months. We will hold a Mass of Remembrance for deceased Knights on November 15, 2022. Ramp for parishioner, Carl Witzel was completed. Our next breakfast will be held April 2nd. \$1000.00 donation to Mary's shelter approved.

Human Concerns:

Forty people went to March for Life on the bus. Half were from our parish.

Evangelization: The Discovering Christ sessions have been very well received. 44 Parishioners are participating. Holy Spirit Retreat Day scheduled for Saturday March 26th in Quinn Hall. Word on Fire Engage 90 day free trial. All Flocknote subscribers will have access to the entire digital library. After the trial we will determine if it should be continued. Cost is \$1900 annually.

Youth Group: Last youth group meeting was March 13th. Seven students attended. April 13-16 will be Holy Week Mission. Wonder Retreat for girls March 18-20. Young men's retreat in May (TBD).
