- Church was painted one time 22 years ago when it was built. Cracks and mars noted throughout building. Father Rich is obtaining two quotes:
  - Robert A Ritterbeck Painting Inc. \$98,850 Time frame will be several months. All services would need to be relocated to Quinn Hall. Based upon Father Rich's past experience, this is a reasonable quote for painting a church. Father Rich is also familiar with this company's work and this company has been known to do beautiful work.
    - Price includes all labor, equipment, and materials (including scaffolding to access ceilings and walls). Also included is all necessary plaster repairs.

- Areas to be included: front sacristy, sanctuary, the main nave, two side naves, baptistry, confessional/cry room and vestibules. Surfaces included in these areas are all ceilings, walls, and trim.
- The company carries all insurances and licenses. This project will include all areas of the church including the sanctuary.
- o St. Jude's Father Rich is waiting for a quote.
- Multiple trees have been removed from the property. Church received \$9,000 from the sale of the black walnut trees.
