The Meaning of the Mass

This is a series of study on the meaning of the Mass. This is prepared by Bishop Daniel. It lets us study and live the Mass.
Part 7 – The Rite of Sending continued

. The assembly comes forth with the Risen Lord and is sent into the world. The Church would have nothing to offer the world unless she herself has first been transformed and made into the Body of Christ in whom she partakes of Trinitarian life. It is Christ Himself that the Church brings to the world. The Church must now show, as Jesus showed, the love that lays down its life for a friend. That’s our mission – to be Eucharist for others. All that has happened in here, we are to take out there. If you are not leaving church with an awareness of mission and an eagerness to bring Christ to others, then you still are not understanding what the Mass is all about.

As we conclude this series of reflections, there are some core understandings to keep in mind and heart:

- The Biblical Basis for the Mass, which makes up 95% of it – if there were no bible references, it would be only a few minutes long.
- The liturgy is not the work we do for God; it is our participation in and acceptance of the work Jesus has done for us through the Cross of Calvary rendered present to us in his Body and Blood of the Eucharist. **It’s not our liturgy, but His liturgy, that we celebrate.**
- Through the Liturgy of the Word, we hear God’s Word and the story of Jesus applied to our lives – we profess our Creed to the Father acknowledging that we have heard his Word spoken to us.
- We offer our lives to become **Sacrifice** – Remember: Sacrifice = Make Holy.
- Our eyes are opened to see the Mystery of Christ present in our midst:
 - The **Word** spoken throughout salvation history that culminates and reaches perfection in the life, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus

- The **Assembly** as the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit, the Body of Christ.
- The **Priest** as the representing Jesus through the Spirit given to him in Ordination – Be Christ for us!
- In the **Eucharist** our lives are changed to become the very presence of Jesus and received back so as to become a living tabernacle.
- We are formed in **Communion** to be the Body of Christ
- The representation by the seven candle stands in the Sanctuary of our participation in the Wedding Banquet of the Lamb.
- We are drawn into heaven and sent back to earth as missionaries to continue the very work of Jesus.

Peace be with you as you proceed on the journey into a deeper appreciation of the mass.
