TAKING A STANCE AGAINST SIN & GIVING MORE OF YOUR HEART

As we celebrated this past Wednesday, this Season of Lent is about TAKING A STANCE AGAINST SIN and GIVING MORE OF OUR HEARTS to the Lord. This is exactly what we see Jesus doing in the Gospel reading today (Mt 4: 1 -11). Right before Jesus was about to officially begin his ministry, he went out into the desert for 40 days to get focused. While there, Satan seized the opportunity to come at Jesus full force with three temptations: be selfserving; test God the Father's love; thirst for power. Each time Jesus took a STANCE AGAINST SIN. Each time Jesus' burdens became more bearable to the extent that the scriptures tell us, "Satan left him and, behold, angels came and ministered to him" (Mt 4: 11). In taking a STANCE AGAINST SIN, God desires to also send His angels to minister to you and to me in order that we can SURRENDER MORE OF OUR HEARTS to the Lord. Whether you choose to give up and/or add spiritual disciplines in your life, know that they are there to help you to TAKE A STANCE AGAINST SIN and GIVE MORE OF YOUR HEART to the Lord. TAKING A STANCE is hard. Satan's temptations will come at you in your most vulnerable of moments. Yet, this 1st week of Lent encourages us, re-energizes us that our chosen spiritual disciplines this Lenten season will give us the courage to TAKE A GREATER STANCE AGAINST SIN and God's angels will help us to GIVE MORE OF OUR HEART to the Lord. What a challenging time. What an exciting time. Every time that you take a STANCE AGAINST SIN God's angels will help you GIVE MORE OF YOUR HEART over to the Lord.
