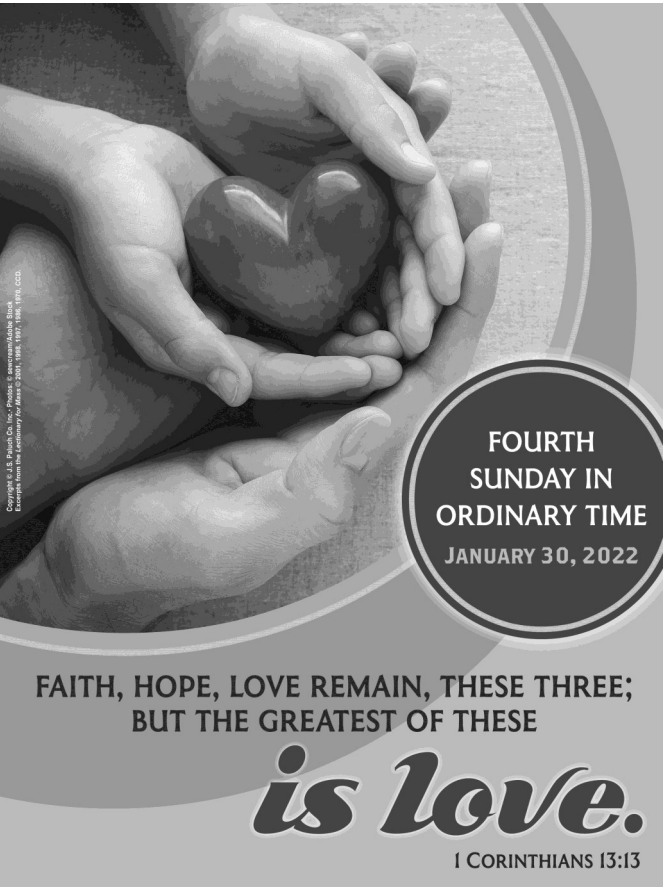

In the Flocknote reflection that I sent out this past week, we mentioned the synodal process that our Diocese is undertaking as a part of the synodal process in our universal Church as requested by Pope Francis. Below are the dates and times when we will be having our synodal sessions here at St Jude:

2/11 - Friday - 10:30 am - after the morning mass
2/16 - Tuesday - 6:30 pm - after the evening mass
2/20 - Sunday - 9:15 am- for adults
2/20 - Sunday - 5:00 pm - for youth

Through the synodal process, we are going to reflect upon our journey as a Christian community, how we see God interacting with our lives as individuals and as a parish. We are going to do this at these sessions through small table discussion, reflecting upon three particular Gospel readings from Luke. We will look at where God is calling us as individuals and as a community. We will look at how we would like the Church and our parish to respond to us in the midst of this reality. I am really looking forward to this synodal process giving us direction as a parish and as a Diocese, as well as helping us in our journey of faith as individuals. I want to encourage all of you to join us for these synodal reflection sessions at St Jude.
