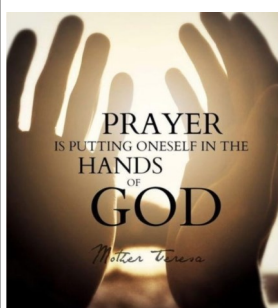


May – A Month to Honor Mary
