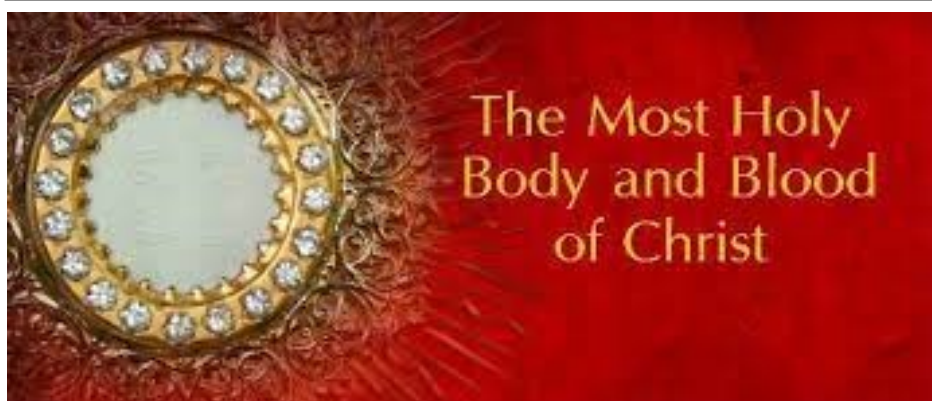

## About Today's Solemnity

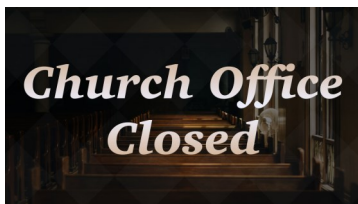

On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as Corpus Christi, we delve into Christ's willingness to sacrifice himself for others. God becoming human in Christ was the beginning of a life devoted to others.



Bishop Kopacz is reassigning Fr. Jofin to Philadelphia, Mississippi where he will be the pastor of Holy Cross in Philadelphia and of Sacred Heart in Louisville. We very much appreciate Fr. Jofin's commitment to St. Jude and the wonderful progress he has made here. I want to especially commend him for his efforts in ministering to all the people of Saint Jude.
