Updates to the Sunday Mass Schedule

Last year, the Community of St. Jude saw an explosion in the number of children participating in Sunday School. What a wonderful problem to have, but it is a problem. The current Sunday schedule forces many families to make multiple trips to drop off and pick up their children for Sunday School and to attend Mass. Since most of the families attend either the 11:00 am or 1:00 pm Masses, it makes sense to adjust the Sunday schedule to minimize the number of trips families must make. By marry-

ing the two Sunday morning Masses and adjusting the time for Sunday School, we can alleviate the problem for families having to make multiple trips on Sunday and develop a greater opportunity for community building. Other benefits of this change include more opportunities for adults to participate in adult faith formation and a less demanding schedule for weekend liturgical ministers.

The staff at St. Jude has been wrestling with how to resolve these issues since March. After a meeting with the Parish Pastoral Council, the following changes are being made to the Weekend Mass Schedule effective the weekend of September 2-3, 2023.





The Adult Faith Formation class in English will meet at 8 a.m. on Sundays beginning Sept. 10 in the Parish Hall.

Last year's study of the Eucharist by Scott Hahn sparked an interest in learning more about Revelation from a Catholic perspective, especially how Revelation contains many aspects of our Mass that are contained in Revelation.

Beginning Sept. 10, AFF will use Jeff Cavins' video series "Revelation: The Kingdom Yet to Come" to "pull back the veil on the rich symbolism present in Revelation," including its

mysterious figures and images and how Revelation is more than just an apocalyptic vision of the end times.

The class will be 10 sessions, ending Nov. 12 before Advent. Class will begin at 8 a.m. with a video that is about 55 minutes. Each week a handout will be provided that includes the chapter being studied and questions for group discussion. Coffee and snacks will be provided. Class will end in time for 9:30 a.m. Mass.

Anyone who desires to get the most from the program should buy the individual workbook from Ascension press for
