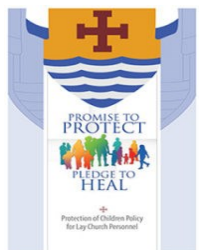
We will have a tight schedule, as each episode is 50+ minutes long, so it will be essential for participants to read through the workbook for the appropriate lesson **before** coming to class.
