
## THINKING ABOUT BECOMING CATHOLIC?

Wednesday, November 1st is the Solemnity of All Saints. Mass will be celebrated at 12:00 pm and 6:00 pm (bilingual).

All Saints' Day is the day after All Hallows' Eve (Hallowe'en). It is a feast day celebrated on 1st November by Anglicans and Roman Catholics. It is an opportunity for believers to remember all saints and martyrs, known and unknown, throughout Christian history.

Parish Re-Imagining Process meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 8th at 6:30 pm. In the Saint Mary's Room. At this meeting we will be discussing how St. Jude should be preparing for the future, especially in light of what was identified as important points at our synod meeting, and in light of the changing demographics of our diocese.



Sunday, November 5 we will begin our #igivecatholic Campaign here at St. Jude. It ends on Tuesday, November 28, which is Giving Tuesday. This Year's #igivecatholic campaign highlights two important needs in our parish, first, raising money for the youth to attend One Bread One Cup and/or Steubenville in Alexandria, LAS and second to help fund replacement of our aging air conditioners in the back of the church.

Six of our youth went to Saint Meinrad Archabbey in Indiana last summer. We would like to take as many as possible again this year, as well as sending youth to Steubenville on the Bayou in Alexandria, LA. Our goal is to have as many youth as possible to attend one or both of these events. We would like to raise \$10,000 to help with this project.

The total goal for I Give Catholic for St. Jude this year is \$21,250 for both of this projects.


