and it will not be taken from her." (Lk 10:42)

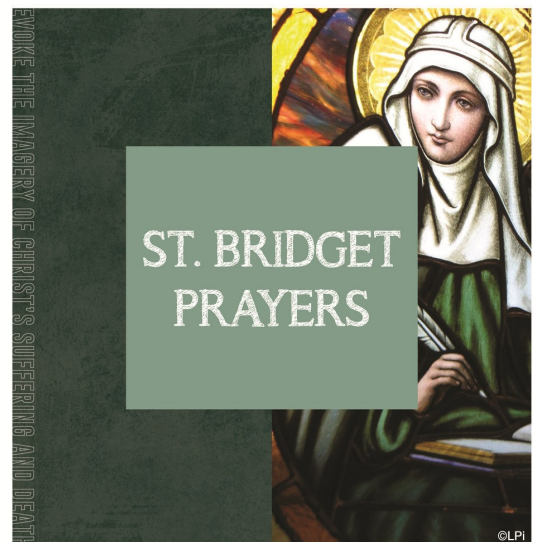
