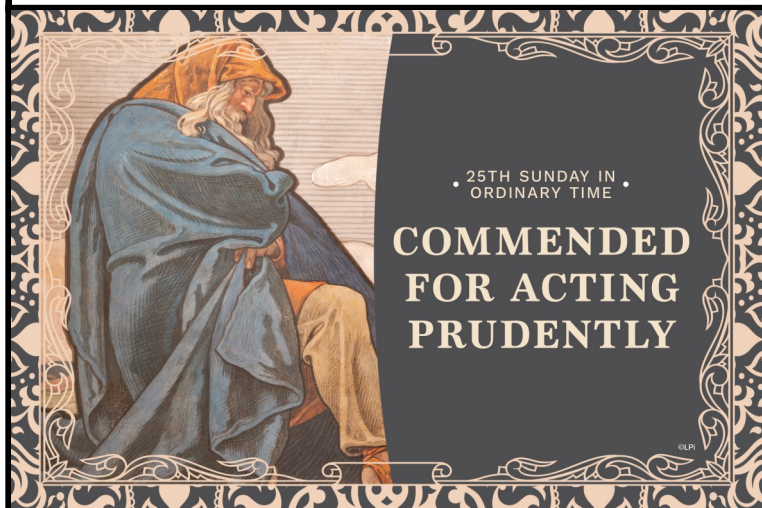
PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

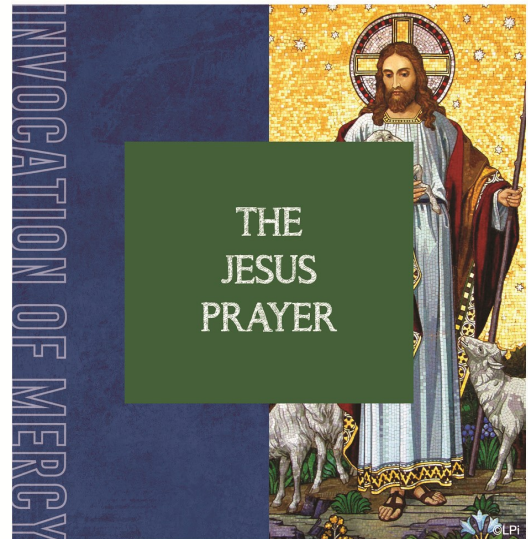
