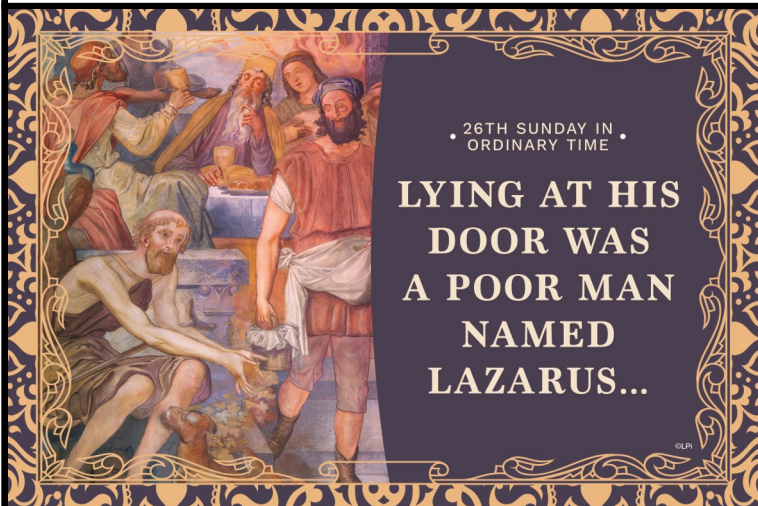
PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

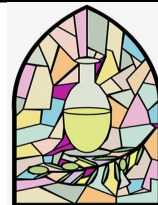

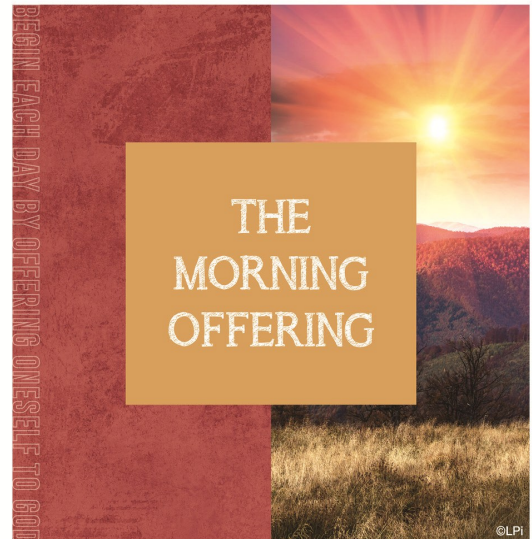
