Magic Woman and her Secret Formula

Nine years ago her dream came true – she lost a great deal of weight. As a result, many wonderful things happened: Her blood pressure went down and her energy level went up. Her feet, knees and back didn't ache any more. She no longer had to shop in the "big" women's stores. But somethings else happened that she hadn't expected. To her family and friends, she became "Magic Woman." How did you do it? They all wanted to know. They were looking for that formula, the certain something to transform them, *zap*, from a size 22 to a size 12. Here is what Magic Woman tells them: "I can tell you what I did: I never gave up. Losing weight was something I deeply desired, and I was relentless. When I found what worked – a way of balancing what I ate with how much I moved my body, my way of

earning a living, my way of connecting with the people I love – I did it with all my heart and soul, every day, without fail. When I messed up, I kept going. When I was afraid, I felt the fear and took the next step into the darkness. When I was confused, I pretended to know which end was up and kept plodding. When I was empty and alone, I reached out to others.

"This morning I weighed myself. But unlike many people I was satisfied with what I saw – a number that has scarcely changed in nine years. And I saw the model for the rest of my life, if I'm willing to use it: Look for the inspired right thing, then do it, without fail – imperfectly but sincerely – one day at a time every day, for the rest of my life. That's the magic."
