**SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT**  
**February 28, 2021**



*This is my beloved Son, with whom I am  
well pleased; listen to him.*  
(*Mathew 17:5*)

In the gospel, Jesus's transfiguration is not only a revelation of divine glory hidden in Jesus, but the transfiguration is closely tied to Jesus's death and resurrection. If you go to St. Mark's gospel and account of the transfiguration, you will see that right before Jesus went up the mountain; Jesus warned his apostles that he would be put to death and would rise again. Immediately after the event, when coming down from the mountain, he tells Peter, James and John, who were with him during the transfiguration, not to tell anyone what they had experienced until he had risen from the dead.

Our season of Lent prepares us to celebrate again what Jesus has done for us in his death and resurrection. We are called to enter into new life with him now so that when our time comes we can enter fully into his glory, some day, as Jesus was changed, we too will be changed in his life through faith, when we lay aside this present life with its joys and sorrows, its triumphs and its weaknesses, we will enter into a glorious new world which Jesus has opened up to us. We too will be transfigured.
