He was without injury, but the people were unaware of him as a grain of mustard seed of which they took no

notice. He chose to be bruised, he chose to be crushed; he chose to be planted in the earth as a seed. For it was in a garden that Christ was taken prisoner, and likewise buried: he sprung up in a garden, where he also rose from the dead, and became a tree. You also then sow Christ in your garden, for a garden is a place that is full of flowers and various fruits in which by virtue of your labor he may grow and breathe forth the multiple sweetnesses of his many virtues. There where fruits are, let Christ be found. Plant the Lord Jesus. He is a seed when a man takes hold of him: he is a tree when he rises again, a tree that give shade to the world; he is a seed when he is buried in the earth, he is a tree when raised to heaven.
