

### ***Third Sunday of Lent***

In this First Reading, we hear how a typical afternoon for Moses tending sheep turns into a surprising and astounding encounter with God on "holy ground." Coming close to the burning bush, Moses hears God's voice, learns God's name, and discovers God's plan to rescue his suffering people. In the Second Reading, St. Paul is warning the Corinthians to live a life always marked by repentance and humility. God's blessings for their ancestors (crossing the Red Sea, eating manna and drinking water in the desert) did

not guarantee salvation. So it is with the Corinthians and with us: "desire for evil things" does not lead to life. God seeks humble, contrite hearts.




## STATIONS of the CROSS


A sincere thank You! To all of our parishioners who have already donated to our Annual Ministry Appeal 2022.

## My Dear Christ Child Family

In response to challenges facing today's Catholic Church, the Holy Father Pope Francis has asked the world's Catholics to participate in the "Synod." Synod means "Journeying together." It involves the Holy Spirit and each other, to discern the path we are called to walk together. The Ordinary Synod of Bishops, 2023, is not just a convening of the Bishops reflecting on a particular topic. Rather, it is the final step in a process of *synodality*, in which the entire Church consults, listens, reflects, and discusses. The goal is to discern the Spirit's lead, so that we might fulfill more effectively, our mission to evangelize the world.

I am asking you to help us answer seven questions that Pope Francis has asked of us:

- 1) *Where and how do you personally experience Church today?*
- 2) *What joys do you experience?*
- 3) *What difficulties and obstacles have you encountered?*
- 4) *What insights do you have?*
- 5) *What is your dream or vision for our church in the future?*

6) *Are there any aspects of the Church's evangelizing mission that you would like to see?*

7) *How do you value the Church's social mission to care for the poor and marginalized, as well as its efforts to address poverty and social change?*
