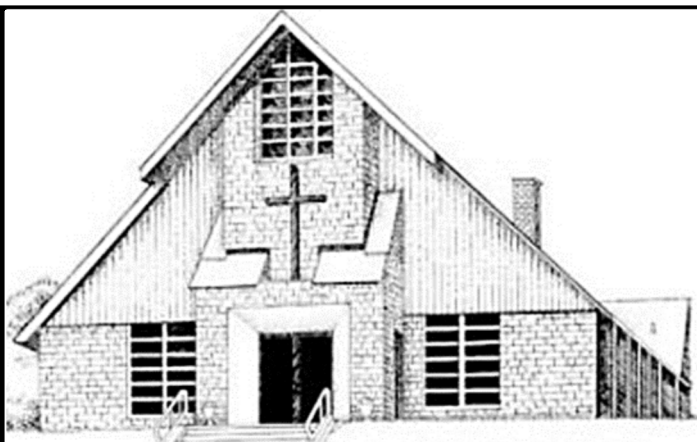

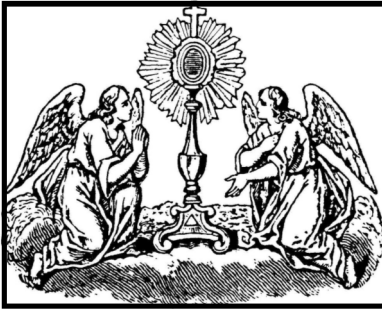

FREE TREES TO HOPATCONG RESIDENTS 2019

The Hopatcong Environmental Commission will be conducting distribution of UP TO 10 FREE TREE SEEDLINGS to borough residents on SAT, MAY 4TH (9 am to 1pm) on the Hopatcong Borough Hall parking lot. The trees are bare-root seedlings ranging in size from 2 ft to 7 ft. in height, depending upon variety.

This is the FINAL YEAR trees are being provided through the NJ Tree Recovery Campaign with the goal of distributing 500,000 tree seedlings to NJ communities to replace trees damaged or destroyed by Superstorm Sandy and subsequent storms in NJ.

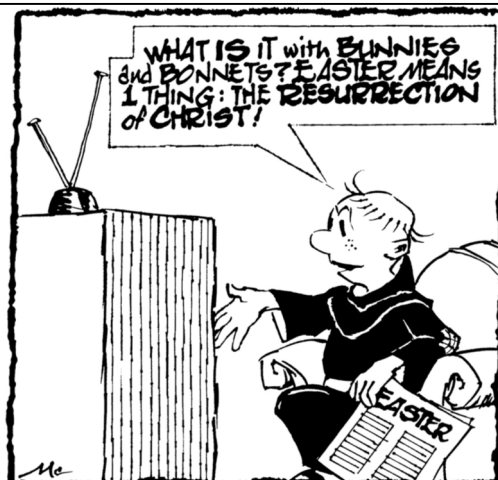

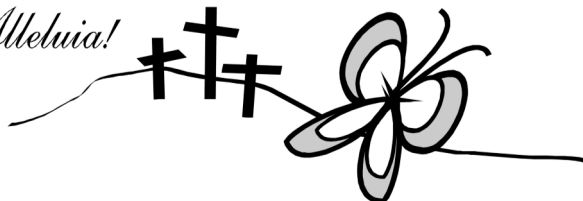

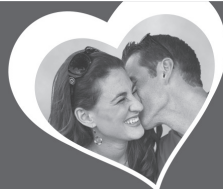
