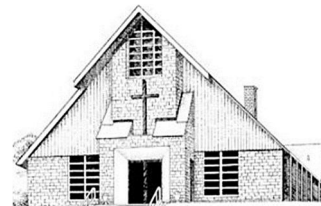

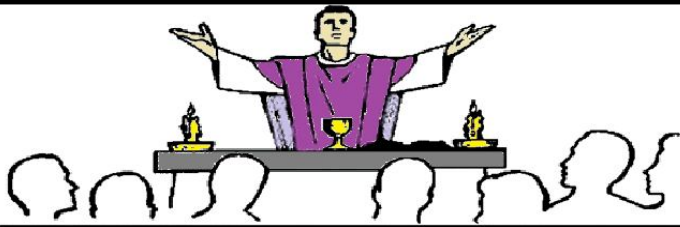
## Welcome to St. Jude's

The group will meet on Sunday, December 13<sup>th</sup> from 12:30-1:30pm in the Meeting Room of the Church.



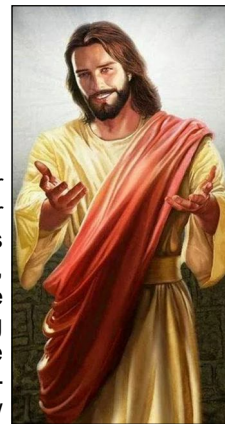

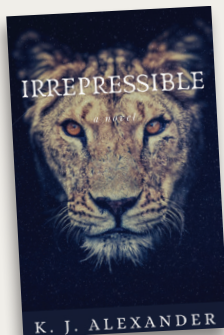
