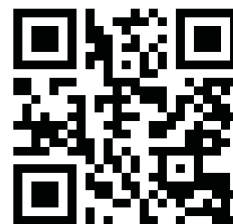

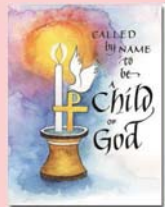

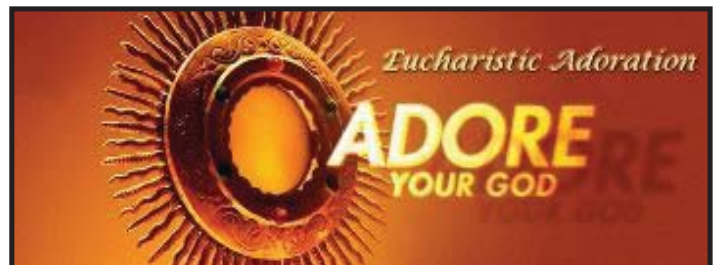

FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

"Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits...' Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them.' So they went off and preached repentance. The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them."

We can picture Jesus calling then sending His chosen ones to begin their mission. They listened to His instruction and then acted upon it, preaching, healing, continuing the work and mission of Jesus. They responded to His call and accepted their responsibility.

The Synod is similar to this scene. Delegates called to listening sessions, invoking the Holy Spirit, leading the church where the Lord wants us to go. Are we willing today to welcome this work of the Lord and listen to what the Spirit is calling us to do? The role of the prophet Amos or as Paul describes we who have been chosen 'so that we might exist for the praise of his glory, we who have hoped in Christ.

A BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF THE SUNDAY READINGS

First Reading: Amos 7:12-15

Amaziah (priest of Bethel) ordered Amos to leave Bethel and never prophesy there again. Amos replied that he had not been a prophet, but was a shepherd until he was called by God.

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:3-14 or 1:3-10

Paul exults God's immeasurable generosity as he recounts all the blessings that have been bestowed upon all God's people. We all became adopted children of God when we heard the message of truth Christ brought to us, and because of it, believed in him.

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

Jesus gave the twelve disciples authority over unclean spirits and sent them out to preach and heal the sick. He advised them to bring nothing with them and to shake the dust from their feet of any town where they had not been welcomed. Jesus wanted them to understand what they would need to do in his place after his death.

LOCAL ALCOHOLIC ANONYMOUS MEETINGS

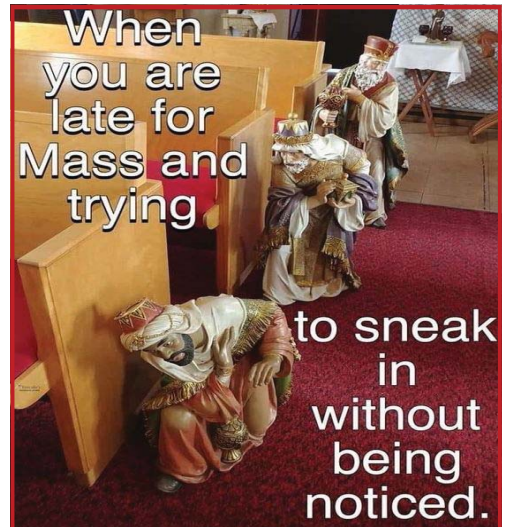
Hopatcong has 4 Alcoholics Anonymous meetings per week

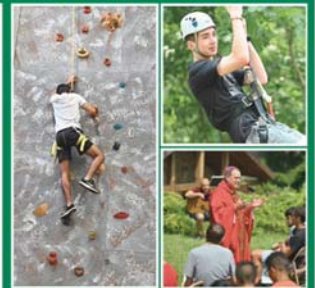

NFP 2.0

A FOUR-PART PODCAST

Did you hear wonderful things about Natural Family Planning before you were married? As you looked at beautiful images of happy couples in NFP materials, did you anticipate the wonders of being able to faithfully plan your family while also enriching your marriage? Has NFP met all those hopes?

If not, don't worry. "Natural Family Planning 2.0" addresses the common issues couples face when NFP meets the reality of living out the Sacrament of Marriage. Building on your deep love for one another and your experiences in marriage, this podcast offers an opportunity to solve some of the most common obstacles couples encounter while offering important insights.

Using NFP Effectively

Session One of NFP 2.0 offers specific ways a married couple can achieve high efficacy using Natural Family Planning. It includes a discussion about important technical considerations when using a method as well as how our marital partnership impacts efficacy.

NFP Doesn't Work For My Body

Session Two focuses on the hormonal imbalances charting with Natural Family Planning can reveal. A description of several types of imbalances are discussed along with possible lifestyle and medical options to help. The session wraps up by considering ways to approach challenges as a mutually supportive, loving partnership.

Managing Different Desires

Natural Family Planning intensifies the challenge of differing levels of desire between a husband and wife. The conversation in this session is wide-ranging and includes basic physiological differences between the spouses, medical obstacles, disillusionment about sexual ideals when love demands sacrifice, and suggestions to consider to create more unity and joy.

Unplanned Pregnancies + Growing Attachment

Session Four lays out suggested groundwork for couples who want to develop the strength to weather any challenge well, including an unplanned pregnancy. Expanding on the Marriage Castle analogy from Session Three, listeners can reflect on attachment, the marital friendship, and rightly ordered sexual union. The challenge of an unplanned pregnancy is discussed, including both best practices and things to avoid.

We are introducing the new National Catechetical Leaders Certificate Program (NCLCP) a great opportunity for catechetical leaders and catechists with an interest in leadership. Through this program you will not only earn a certification to work in the catechetical field, acquiring the skills needed to create a catechetical plan for your parish, but also learn how to respond to the challenges faced in catechesis today (See attached for details). This 12 month long, hybrid program, consists mostly of online sessions, with some meetings in person. Upon successful completion, the student may receive 18 credits university credits. Scholarship opportunities are available from the *Diocesan Lay Ministry Leadership Formation Grant*. If interested, please contact the catechetical office. 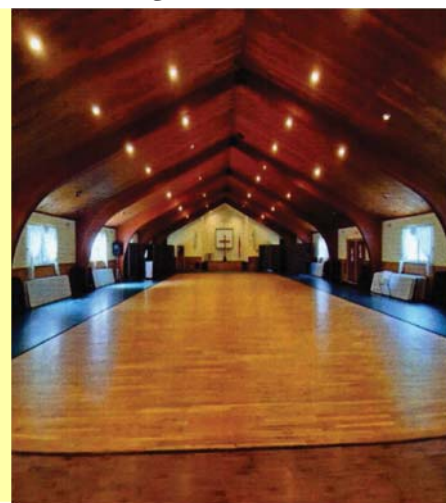

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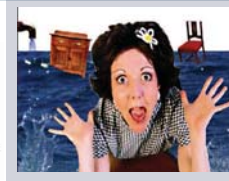
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
