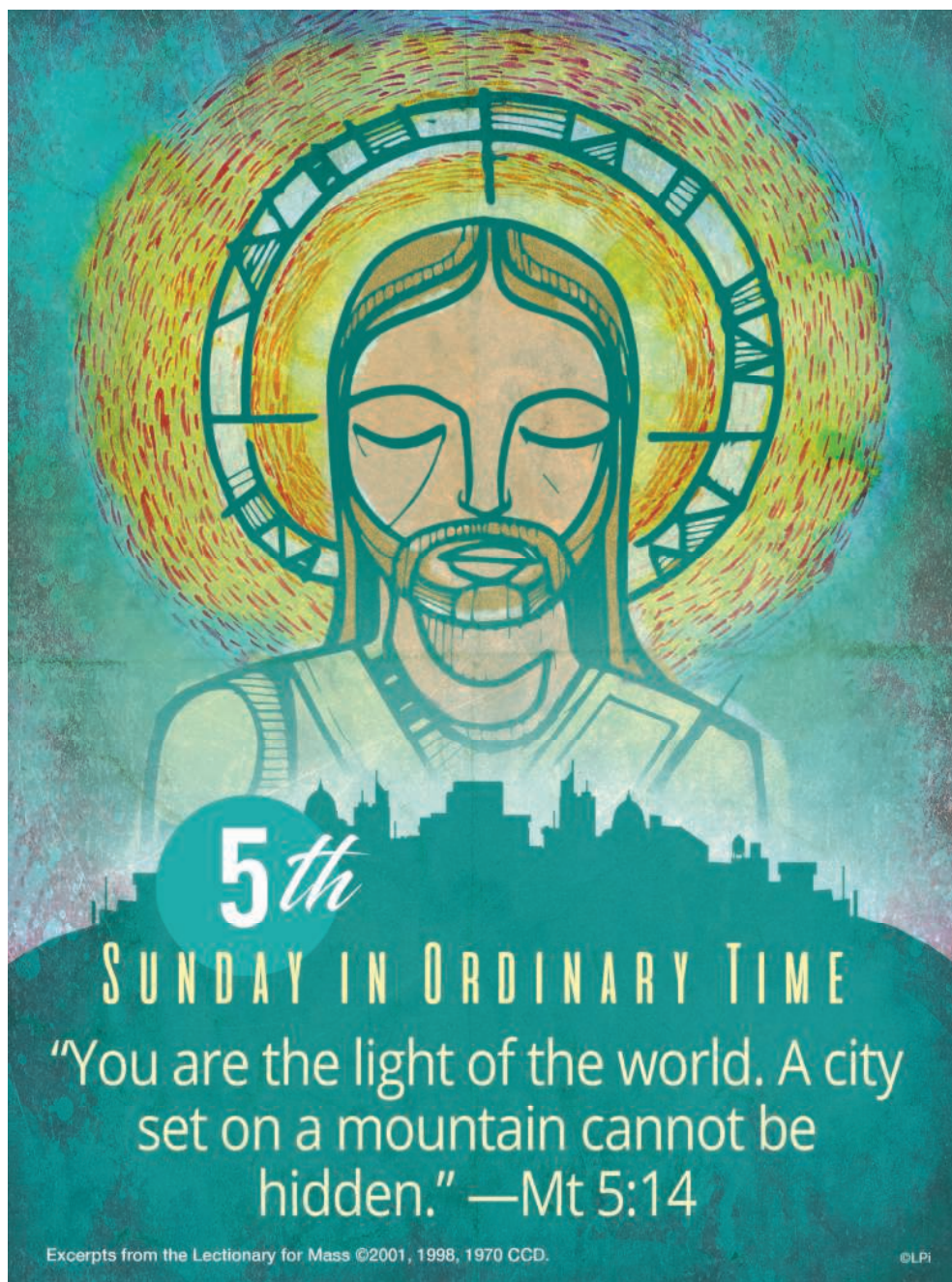

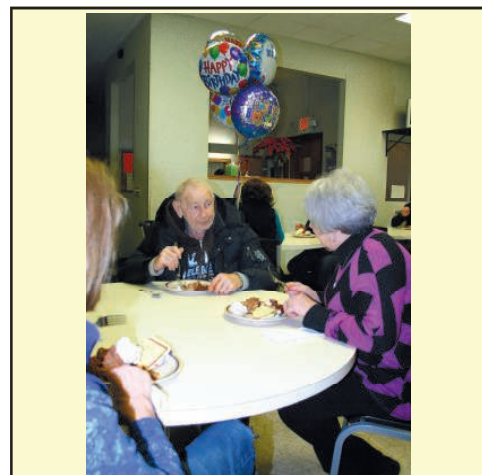
## Leonetti to discuss Italy trip

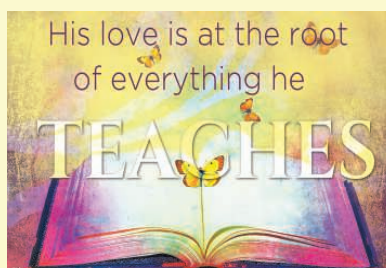

St. Mary's Hospital is looking for volunteers, who enjoy knitting, crocheting or sewing.

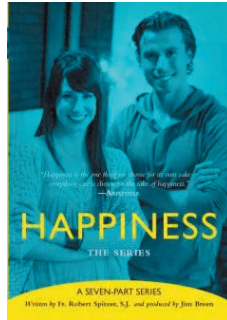

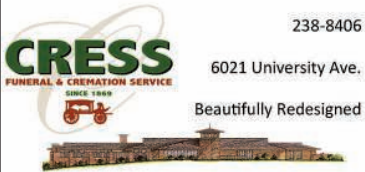
