A message from Justin Rodrigue, Executive Manager & Development Director...

It was Oct. 2019 when I last spoke to you about stewardship and the state of our parish. The gift of stewardship begins with love. Love for God and your parish. Both are very evident here at St. Genevieve!

Thanks to Covid, we sort of went into "survival" mode. Coming to church ended, watching Mass on Social Media started, and we couldn't see and worship with our church family in person. How devastating that was for so many. As a staff, we livestreamed Masses and other worship events in an empty church, we couldn't help but feel a sense of being alone in the dessert, missing seeing all of the familiar faces we saw each weekend. We knew the importance of staying connected with you all.

One thing did not change was the support of you, our parishioners. As other churches struggled, we struggled a little less because we knew we could count on your support and faithfulness and for that I say THANK YOU!

Now as we are seeing our attendance back to pre Covid numbers with as many as 800 attending our weekend Masses, we are also seeing a rise in new families joining our parish. Since June of this year, 31 families have joined our parish. Our future looks bright and we are truly blessed!

We are constantly working hard with ways to deepen the faith and bring others closer to Christ. Our adult and youth formation programs are flourishing. Fr. Eric, Fr. Joseph and our staff are here for you and we care greatly about the needs of you all.

Our parish is blessed to be debt-free. Although we still have all of the expenses to run the day to day operations, your continued support helps us greatly in moving our parish forward.

As we begin to offer more opportunities for our young adult and youth formation programs, monies are needed to help offer the many things being planned.

Presently, we have 1200 families registered at St. Gen. Of the 1200 families, an average of 590 choose to receive weekly envelopes. We receive back and average of 107 envelopes per week and about 230 give online. The other 863 either put in the loose collection or do not contribute, meaning only 30% of those registered families support our parish.

We are fortunate to also rely on foundations such as the Peltier and Lorio among others, when large unexpected expenses arise like the recent replacement of one of the church's A/C units at a cost of over \$27,000. The Lorio Foundation Grant we applied for paid for this expense without affecting our budget. We are indeed blessed by these very generous foundations.

We are so very grateful for your generous support of our parish and ask you today to prayerfully consider increasing your donation if you are able to. We do understand that times are very tough right now! If you are presently not contributing, we ask that you prayerfully consider signing up for our electronic banking or our new online giving option (see page 5). Both make it easy to contribute ensuring that we have the funds to operate even if you have to attend Mass elsewhere due to your schedule. To sign up these options can be found on our website or call the office for assistance.

In closing, I want to leave you with this, blessings come from giving, I understand this is a hard concept to understand for some. As I began to give more to my parish both financially and of time and talent, the more I received. As we give, we receive many more blessings from God. Working together as one family, we can accomplish so much.




