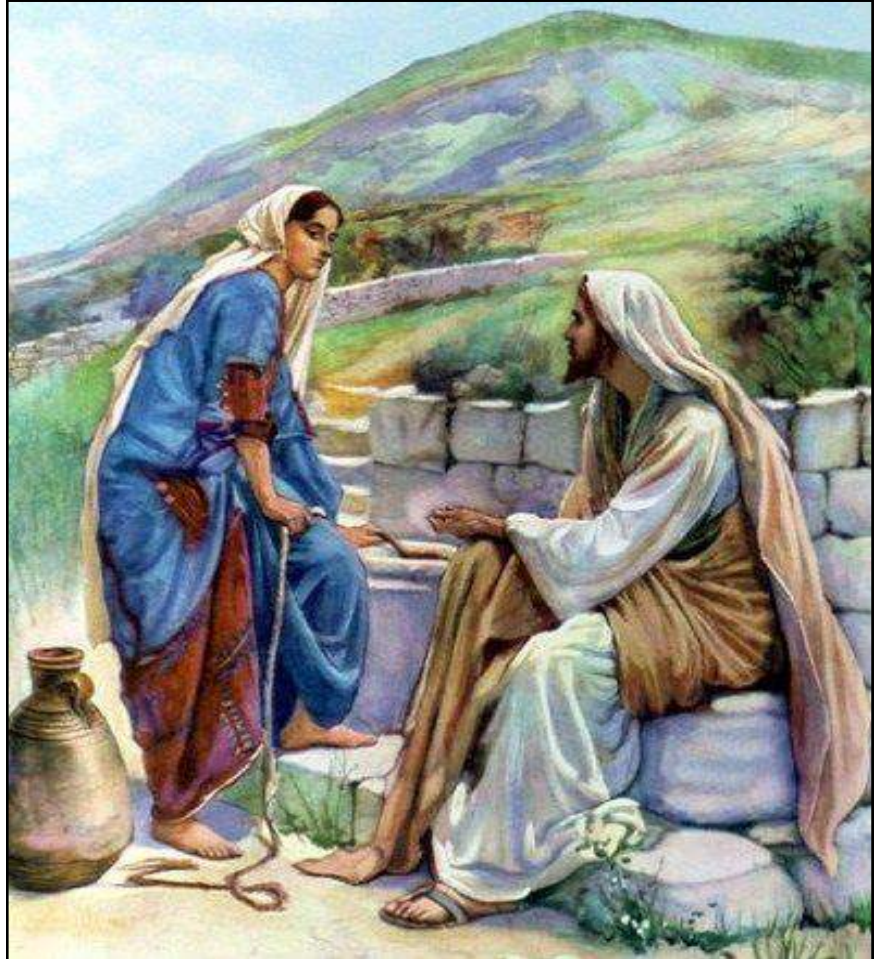

**POWERFUL PRAYER TO SAINT MICHAEL**

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do Thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host - by the Divine Power of God - cast into hell, satan and all the evil spirits, who roam throughout the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.



Grace and peace to you. As we approach the midpoint of Lent, a time for reflection and spiritual growth, let us examine our hearts and seek to deepen our connection with Him. How have we responded to the call to prayer, fasting, charitable giving, and the observance of abstinence on Fridays?

The Passion and death of Jesus Christ on the Cross remain the ultimate sacrifice, a profound act of love offered on behalf of all humanity. As Isaiah reminds us, “But he was pierced for our sins, crushed for our iniquity. He bore the punishment that makes us whole, by his wounds we were healed” (Is. 53:5). The Fridays of Lent serve as a powerful reminder of this sacrifice, a time to reflect on Christ’s willingness to give his life for us.

At the heart of our faith lies the Paschal Mystery – Jesus’ life, suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension. This mystery, rooted in the Greek word “Pascha” (Easter), invites us to explore the depths of Jesus’ saving work, a study known as soteriology. We see Jesus as a divine physician, healing the sick and wounded; as a divine reconciler, offering forgiveness to all who seek it; and as the perfect sacrifice, the “Lamb of God,” whose death ushered in eternal life.

The Paschal Mystery is made accessible to us through the sacraments, outward signs of God’s grace instituted by Christ. Baptism washes away Original Sin and opens us to the life of grace, while the Eucharist allows us to partake in the Real Presence of Christ’s body and blood. Through confirmation, we are sealed with the Holy Spirit, and through the other sacraments, we are united to Christ’s saving work.

During this season of Lent, let us especially cherish the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick. Reconciliation offers us the opportunity to receive Christ’s forgiveness and mercy, a grace we can always seek with contrite hearts. The Anointing of the Sick, as Jesus demonstrated with the Apostles, brings healing and peace to mind, body, and soul, and assures us of God’s continued presence in our lives. During Lent, the sacrament of Reconciliation is offered on Tuesdays during Adoration at 7PM. The sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is available by appointment; please call the Parish Office to make an appointment.

This weekend, our Catechumens focus on the first of three Scrutinies. Our readings all focus on the awesome significance of Baptism, which they will receive on the night of the Easter Vigil. First, the Lord commands Moses to strike the rock of Mt. Horeb, which brings forth life-giving water for the Israelites, a foreshadowing of baptism; St. Paul says the love of God is poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, given at baptism; and Jesus speaks with the Samaritan woman at the well, teaching her about the life-giving waters of baptism. He tells her, “whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” This is made possible through the action of the Holy Spirit—the same Spirit who led our catechumens to Christ and His Church.

May we continue to grow in faith, hope, and love throughout this holy season, guided by the transformative power of the Holy Spirit as we continue to ponder the Paschal Mystery.
