From The Pastor's Desk



May the Lord give you His peace. It seems this summer is just flying by! I hope everyone has been enjoying the beautiful weather and soaking up the sun. Our Religious Formation office has been busy preparing for the upcoming Children's Religious Formation year. Registration is open, so feel free to register your children now. Registering now helps to prevent our staff from having to process too many registrations all at once, and also ensures that you have first pick for which day you would like your child(ren) to attend. We are looking forward to another fun year of growing in the faith with our students.

I am happy to share that we were able to have some of the larger potholes in the parking lot patched. Last winter was devastating to most parking lots, including St. Isaac's. Nevertheless, we just received a generous gift from the paving company who recently paved Elmwood Road. They did this in exchange for allowing them to store some of their equipment in the church parking lot while that project was underway. A special thanks to Nancy Jamanow for helping to coordinate with all involved.

One of the highlights of August is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Since this solemnity falls on a Saturday, it is **not** a Holy Day of Obligation. But, for those who would like to celebrate the Assumption, our regularly scheduled Friday Mass in Latin will be held on Friday, August 14 at 7PM in the church. Again, there is no obligation to attend Mass for the Assumption, but the option remains for those who would like to attend.

Our readings this weekend focus us on the New Covenant. The prophet Isaiah speaks of renewing an everlasting covenant, the benefits assured to David. These benefits are the fulfillment of the promise the Lord makes to David, "when your days have been completed and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring after you, sprung from your loins, and I will establish his kingdom" (2 Sm. 7:12). St. Paul declares that nothing will separate us from the love of Christ. That love remains with us in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar.

In the Gospel, Jesus multiplies the loaves and fish so that he could feed five thousand men, not counting women and children. Needless to say, this was a great miracle that nourished weary souls. When we come to Mass, we also witness a similar multiplication. As St. Paul says, "Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf" (1 Cor. 10:17). That is to say, the Communion we all share unites us as one body with Christ Himself, who is our Head. And so, as we continue to enjoy the summer months and look forward to vacations and time off with our families, let us be ever more aware that Christ is present in our midst, especially in Holy Communion, but also wherever two or more are gathered in His name.
