
### A Note From Our Pastor V. Rev. Daniel Greenleaf



### A Reflection on Matthew 16:13-19: Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

In Matthew 16:16, Simon Peter declares a powerful confession of faith that affirms Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of the living God. Jesus acknowledges this confession as divinely revealed and promises to build his Church on St. Peter's faith. This confession also applies to Paul because his writings and actions demonstrate his belief in Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God.

We learned that both St. Peter and St. Paul rooted this confession in their unique experiences and theological contributions. St. Peter's confession stems from his direct experience with Jesus' ministry, such as his teachings, miracles, and authority. Unlike St. Peter, St. Paul was transformed from a prosecutor to be an apostle by the risen

Jesus. He reinterpreted scriptures like Isaiah 53 and Psalm 110 to demonstrate Jesus as the Messiah who fulfills God's redemptive plan through his death and resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:3-4). Both St. Peter and St. Paul saw Jesus as the Messiah who fulfills Israel and the Gentiles' hopes. Their confession became a cornerstone of early Christian faith.

Reflecting on this confession, we should ask ourselves: Do we have any experiences about Jesus since we became a Christian? Do we demonstrate Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God to others as Peter and Paul did? Let us ask St. Peter and St. Paul to intercede for each of us in our journey of following Jesus Christ and bearing witness to him!




