A Note From Our Pastor V. Rev. Daniel Greenleaf

Dear Parishioners,

My heart is full of gratitude for the experience of the final Masses at Our Lady of the Rosary and Holy Cross Church. As sad as the reality was, so many parishioners came to gather, tell stories, and support each other. It was a beautiful testimony to the faith and the Catholic heritage in the parish. I have to thank the office for all the work they did, Jen and Joline especially. Moreover, the staff at Dignity Memorial, Roger, Ray, Ann, and their staff were professional and accommodating, and the volunteers, Denise, the sacristan, music people, and other ministries. It takes a lot to put something like this together, and they did it with such care and love that are part of why we are such a great parish. Thank you so much from the bottom of my heart. I also want to thank all those who attended the Masses. I know it was a sad day, but together we can support each other knowing that our faith keeps us going. One more thank you has to go to those who came to the 8:30 Mass at Holy Family last week. The new book that I would like to read with the parish is called, "Return: How to Draw Your Child Back to the Church." It is written by Brandon Vogt, who works with Bishop Barron on the Word on Fire Catholic Ministries. I think it is a practical and spiritual way of helping parents deal with the experience of their children rejecting the Catholic faith. I bought 500 of them to get the discount price of \$15.00 a book. The original price is \$29.00. Inside each book will be an envelope for you to use to reimburse the parish for the book. You can put the envelope in the collection basket or mail it to the office; whichever is most convenient for you. There are also study and reflection guides that we will make available to help work your way through the book. In September, I hope to read the book for our Monday night Catholic adult sessions, but I wanted to get it into as many hands as possible to start the discussion because I think it is a particularly important topic that is on the minds of many Catholic parents.

I have been working with Tyler to start a Family and Faith Commission where I have invited parents to gather with us to discuss how to connect and minister to families today. This commission is just a "think tank" with the objective to help the parish support and enrich Catholic families of today. Too often, I believe that we often are working in outdated ways that no longer work, but since it is all we know, we keep doing the same thing hoping for different results. I do believe that we have to come up with new ways to reach people with our timeless and unchanging faith. Stay tuned for more in the coming months.

A Reflection on Luke 10:25–37: 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In this Sunday's Gospel, a scholar of the law asked Jesus: "Who is my neighbor?" In response, Jesus gave him the parable of the Good Samaritan. The parable tells that there was a man who "fell victim to robbers as he went down from Jerusalem to Jericho." He was stripped, beaten, and left half-dead on the road. Passing by him, there was a priest and a Levite who saw him but did not recognize him as their neighbor. Meanwhile, a Samaritan traveler came upon him, took care of him, bandaged his wounds, and took him to the nearest inn for emergency treatment, and was even willing to pay all the expenses.

Jesus taught the scholar of the law that this Good Samaritan became a neighbor to the beaten man.

In this parable, the scholar might have learned that it was not the priest or the Levite who showed compassion, but rather a Samaritan—someone who was considered an enemy of the Jew. Paradoxically, the religious leaders, who were the beaten man's neighbor, just walked on by and treated the man as a stranger, while the Samaritan treated the man with mercy. Therefore, Jesus said to him: "You also go and do likewise."

Reflecting on this urgent command: "Go and do likewise." Let us go and do as the Good Samaritan did. We may follow the teaching of St. Mother Teresa, who said, "If you can't feed a hundred people, then feed just one." This is also a good way to show that we are brothers to everyone.
