A Note From Our Pastor V. Rev. Daniel Greenleaf

Dear Parishioners,

The parish is offering the book, *Return: How to Draw Your Children Back to the Church.* The book is published by Word on Fire with a forward by Bishop Robert Barron. The author, Brandon Vogt, who works closely with Bishop Barron, offers ways of responding to the greatest thing that causes Catholic parents' hearts to ache. The culture is offering many other ways to live without the need for faith in God, which seems easily attractive for people today. However, it does not mean that we have to throw our hands up and give up. Join me in reading the book and for the month of September, when everyone comes back from our short summer break, I would like to use my Monday night sessions discussing our options. I hope to stream it online for those who are not able to get out. Please pick up a book. I bought 500 at the half price of \$15 a book. Each book has an envelope that can be placed in the collection basket or brought to the office to help reimburse the fund to purchase the next books. I anticipate that it will be a lively and profitable discussion that will be relevant for many parents today.

We had our first meeting of our Faith and Family Commission. We pulled a group of parents together who are trying so hard to raise their children in a Catholic home environment. Over this coming school year, we hope to discuss the trials and blessings for parents and what we can do as a parish to help support Catholic parents in their duty. Generations ago, it was passed down through the culture and family, but times have changed and most families do not have this kind of influence on their family life. Please visit our website as we begin this ministry.

Do you know anyone who is thinking about Catholicism? The parish is running Wednesday night inquiry sessions in the entrance way of Holy Family Church. The OCIA (formerly, RCIA) program starts with people coming to ask questions about faith and the process of becoming Catholic. As a parishioner, always be ready to assist anyone thinking about God and faith and who is asking questions. This way, you are instruments of God's work by assisting others in their journey to find God and meaning in their lives. Inquiry is the first step to an adult becoming Catholic, and you are the vehicle to facilitate the process. It definitely changes lives.

A Reflection on Luke 10:38-42: 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In this Sunday's Gospel, Luke tells us the different attitudes of Martha and Mary toward having Jesus in their home. Mary sits at Jesus's feet, listening to his teaching. Martha, meanwhile, is busy serving the food. When Martha complains, Jesus treats her gently: "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her."

The "one thing" Jesus refers to is the kind of attentive presence and spiritual focus that Mary embodies: placing God first. Jesus does not criticize Martha's work, but He criticizes her attitude of being too busy and anxious. Here, He invites her

to know how to rest and how to maintain inner peace.

Reflecting on this story, Jesus also invites us to examine our own lives. We should ask ourselves: Do we make time for God? We should learn that the Mass is "one thing" we need. It is not something we do for God, but it is something God does for us. He sets up the Table of the Eucharist. He is the host of the meal for us in every single Mass. Like Mary, who chose the "one thing" by prioritizing Jesus's presence, attending Mass is choosing to sit at Christ's feet, receiving the word of God and the Eucharist. Therefore, we must make time for God by attending Mass, at least Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation.






